- Limit to peer-reviewed publications to find high quality, academic journals

- ➤ JournalFinder –look up journals by title, ISSN, or subject. Use the 'Choose a subject' option to identify journals in a specific field. All titles are full-text for the years listed. JournalFinder also includes the print holdings of the Library.


