



Application to Live Off-Campus

Student Life Office

Sterling College is a residential campus. As such, students are required to live on campus unless they meet one of the following criteria as of the first day of the semester in question:

1. A married student
2. A student with dependents, who is serving as the custodial parent
3. A fifth year student in good academic standing
4. At least 23 years of age and in good academic standing
5. A student living with a parent or legal guardian
6. A part-time student

Possible Off-Campus Opportunity for Fall 2008

Because we may be expecting a larger enrollment this fall semester, other students may be granted to live off-campus if they meet the following criteria by the end of the Spring 2008 semester. **Students in this category will still need to rush for a room, and will not be notified if they are granted permission to live off-campus until July 1st, 2008.**

1. Have senior status (completed 94 or more credits).
2. Have a 2.75 cumulative gpa.
3. Be in good status through the student life office.

In exceptional circumstances, permission to live off-campus may be given to a student who does not meet any of the above requirements. In such situations, applications may be referred to the Housing Committee for a decision.

Please remember:

- The deadline for applications for the following fall semester is May 1 and the deadline for the following spring semester is December 1. Applications received after this time will not be considered.
- Students who are found to have provided fraudulent or misleading information on their application will be charged for room and board for the semester in question.
- Students who have received permission to live off-campus must inform the Student Life Office of any changes that would affect their eligibility to live off-campus.
- Students choosing to live off-campus will forfeit one third of their institutional financial aid.
