April

25 Please pray for the election of the new Student Government Association members; pray that godly men and women will be placed in these positions of campus leadership.

26 Love Sterling, a community service event, is taking place today. Thank God for all of the volunteers who have come together to work at this event, and ask Him to bless their efforts and the people they serve.

27 Several students have weddings coming up soon. Please pray for these new marriages as well as any last minute planning the couples must complete.

28 Pray that God will encourage us all to spread the Good News with words and actions of love. "Without love, they will be like a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal" (1 Cor. 13:1).

29 In the busyness of the end of the academic year for faculty and staff, pray that God will provide them with good health and energy to finish the semester.

30 Pray that SC alumni will find opportunities to refer and recruit students who would benefit from attending Sterling.

May

1 Please pray for the Campus Activities Board as they organize the end-of-the-year events for the students.

2 Pray for the persecuted Church as Christians around the world struggle to act out and share their faith.

3 The One-Act plays are this weekend and are always a fun end to the theatre season; pray that all of the actors and directors will rejoice and thank God for their talents and experiences.

4 Tomorrow is the choir's Masterworks concert; ask God to use the students' voices to bless their audience and that the words of praise will touch the hearts of everyone listening.
