1) Gilbraitti Scholarship - \$500 – 1 Award (Deadline: March 30th, 2013)

To be eligible for the Gilbraitti Scholarship a student must:

- 1) Be between the ages of 16-20
- 2) Must be attending a College or University in the Fall of 2013. ⁽¹¹⁾
- 3) Must complete the application form, including the essay prior to the deadline of March 30th, 2013.

2) Youth Volunteer Scholarship Award - \$500 – 1 Award (Deadline: April 15th, 2013)

To be Eligible for the Youth Volunteer Scholarship Award:

1. Over the past 2 years a student must have completed a minimum of 50 hours of volunteer work.
2. Over the past 2 years a student must have maintained a GPA of 3.5 or greater.
3. A student must be under the age of 21 years of age on the day of the deadline.
4. A student must submit an essay on this year's topic.

3) Healthy Choices Scholarship - \$500 – 1 Award (Deadline: April 30th, 2013)

To be eligible for the Healthy Choices Scholarship you must:

1. Be attending an accredited post-secondary institution by the fall of 2013.
2. A student can be enrolled at any level in any program that is two years in length or longer.
3. Students must be Canadian or U.S. residents.

4) Scholarship by Design Award - \$500 – 1 Award (Deadline: May 1st, 2013)

To be eligible for the Scholarship by Design Award a student must:

- 1) Be currently attending school as a high school senior or as an undergraduate student.
- 2) Be a resident of either Canada or the United States.
- 3) Be currently attending school on a full-time basis.

5) Black and Lee Scholarship - \$500 – 2 Awards (Deadline: May 15th, 2013)

To be eligible for the Black and Lee Scholarship a student must:

- 2) Submit answers to the essay question prior to the deadline.
- 3) Be attending a post-secondary institution by the Fall of 2013.

- B) In the fall of 2013, you must be attending a school in Canada or the United States.

7) LM Scholarship Program - \$1,000 – 1 Award (Deadline: May 31st, 2013)

To be considered eligible for the LM Scholarship Program you must be:

Currently enrolled or expects to be enrolled in a degree program (2 years of length or greater) by September. Additionally, to be eligible a student must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and submit an answer to the essay question prior to the submission deadline.

8) Rogers Community Volunteer Scholarship - \$500 – 1 Award (Deadline: June 1st, 2013)

In order to be eligible for the Rogers Community Volunteer Scholarship Program, you must be attending school on a full-time basis during the fall of 2013 and be enrolled in an undergraduate degree program at any level. Additionally, you must have contributed a minimum of 10 hours of non-paid, volunteer service within your community during the last 12 months and have maintained a Grade Point Average of 2.5 or greater.

9) Sedary & Associates Scholarship - \$500 – 1 Award (Deadline: June 15th, 2013)

To be eligible for the Sedary & Associates scholarship a student must:

- 2) Be enrolled in a college, university, trades, or technical school by no later than the Fall of 2013.
- 3) Submit an essay answering the question on the sponsors website.
