

# CAMP ART STAFF WANTED!!

## WHAT IS KAMAJI???

Kamaji is a residential summer camp for girls located in Northern Minnesota. Each summer, 150 girls (ages 7-15) and 80+ staff members come together to enjoy the magic of camping.

## WHAT DOES AN ART VILLAGE INSTRUCTOR/CABIN COUNSELOR DO???

An Art Village Instructor works collaboratively with 5 other co-instructors to develop arts&crafts, painting, drawing, photography, ceramics and pottery projects. The projects should be fun, creative, challenging and yet achievable for campers of all ages. Instructors will be expected to come up with different project ideas, order supplies, make sample projects, teach the campers, stay organized, operate the kiln- amongst other things! We aren't looking for just the typical "crafts" projects but ideas that are original and attractive to girls 7-15 years old.

Instructors will teach 4 periods a day, each an hour long. Our campers choose what activities they take each week so each period will consist of girls of all different ages and skill abilities. In addition to Art Village responsibilities and instructor might be asked to assist in other activities.

We hire all camp activity instructors to also work as cabin counselors. A cabin counselor works with two co-counselors to act as a mother, father, sister, friend, mentor, disciplinarian, teacher and role model to a group of 8-12 girls for at least 4 weeks at a time. Applicants should be spontaneous, flexible, fun-loving, child-like without being childish, and full of TLC.

## WHAT IS THE SUMMER EMPLOYMENT PERIOD???

Minimally, all Kamaji's art staff work from June 7<sup>th</sup> until August 12<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

## WHAT IS THE SALARY???

Competitive Salary based upon education, experience, qualifications, etc. Salaries range from \$2000 to \$2200 for the minimum employment period of June 8<sup>th</sup> through August 12<sup>th</sup>. Additional compensation is provided in the form of room and board plus a transportation allowance ranging from \$100 to \$400. Additional weekly salary beginning at \$200 per week for pre- and post-season work.
