Expanded Academic ASAP

- Find thousands of current full-text articles on history, culture, and civilization.
- Limit to peer-reviewed publications to find high quality, academic journals.
- A general search for “French Revolution” yielded 25 full-text peer-reviewed academic journal articles!



Academic Search Premier

Searching:

- Learn how to search efficiently by viewing the tutorial ‘Advanced Search with Guided Style’ at <http://support.epnet.com/training/tutorials.php>
- Search within a particular journal (**PUBLICATIONS**) or for a specific person (**Leopold I**)
- Limit to peer-reviewed publications to find high quality, academic journals

Boolean Operators

AND (narrows a search)	OR (broadens a search)	NOT (narrows a search)
Each result contains all search terms.	Each result contains at least one search term.	Results do not contain the specified terms.
The search <i>heart</i> and <i>lung</i> finds items that contain both <i>heart</i> and <i>lung</i> .	The search <i>heart</i> or <i>lung</i> finds items that contain either <i>heart</i> or items that contain <i>lung</i> .	The search <i>heart</i> not <i>lung</i> finds items that contain <i>heart</i> but do not contain <i>lung</i> .



Journals Print and Online

- Find out which journals are available full-text online, in the library, or via Interlibrary Loan.
- For example: a search for “18th Century” journal titles yielded 4 titles including *Eighteenth-Century Life* and *Eighteenth-Century Studies*.

Books

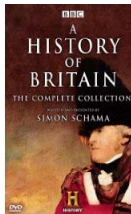
- Hundreds of titles covering the history of the world are in the **900's** section of the Library's stacks. Books **CAN** be checked out for 3 weeks.
- The **REFERENCE** section has a number of books covering the history of the world, including multiple atlases, dictionaries, chronologies, national biographies, and an **Atlas of World History (911 Ox2o)**.
- Call Number Breakdown:
 - 900-909: General geography and history
 - 910-919: Geography and travel, including historical geography.
 - 920 & 929: Biography and genealogy (921-928 not used)
 - 930-939: History of the Ancient World
 - 940-949: History of Europe.
 - 950-959: History of Asia
 - 960-969: History of Africa
 - 970-979: History of North America
 - 980-989: History of South America
 - 990 & 993-999: History of other parts of the World, Australia, New Zealand, Antarctica, and Atlantic Ocean Islands.

All high-quality, peer-reviewed items—**books, journals and DVDs**—are marked with this label.



Current Periodicals

- The Library subscribes to several current journals/magazines covering topics in world history and politics including **History Today (905 H62hi)**, **American History (973.05 Am3ah)**, and **National Geographic (910.5 N21n)**.
- Current issues are kept in the library Pavilion (center aisle). Back issues are stored in the stacks under the assigned call number.
- Periodicals **CAN** be checked out for 3 days

- The Library own several movies and documentaries covering topics in Western Civilization, including DVDs about Napoleon (**944.05 N16n 2000**), Vladimir Lenin (**947.0841 L54v 1997**), and World War I (**940.3 F51f 2005**).
