Assistant Football Coach

Reports to: Head Football Coach/Athletic Director

Description:

Reporting to the Head Football Coach and serving the entire football program, this person is responsible for coaching, mentoring, guiding, and recruiting football student-athletes. This is a full-time staff position with other duties as assigned by the Head Coach.

Qualifications:

A qualified candidate must have a personal commitment to Jesus Christ and support the Christian character and mission of Sterling College. The candidate must also possess a clear understanding of and ability to articulate the essentials of a Christian liberal arts college.

Other qualifications include:

- Excellent people skills and communication abilities.
- Proven leadership skills.
- Excellent organizational, management, and supervisory skills are necessary.
- Ability to accurately connect multiple concepts and multitask.
- Ability to work well with others.
- Capacity to grasp and communicate precise details to small groups of coaches and/or players within the context of our larger vision for the program.
- Ability and willingness to recruit year-round.

Responsibilities:

- Coach assigned position.
- Collaborate with either and/or both coordinators on personnel and schematics of football.
- Assist with the football academic success program.
- Assist in the organization and efficiency of our compliance process.
- Assist in recruiting both on and off campus.
- Assist in the organization of team equipment.
- Assist, when needed, in the organization of team video.

Essential Job Functions:

- Must be able walk up and down stairs.
- Must be able to sit for long periods of time.
- Be able to coordinate movement of the fingers and hands as well as have the adequate dexterity and strength to complete tasks.
- Be able to work on a computer and use a 10 key, copier, printer and phone.
- Must be able to push, pull, and lift up to a minimum of 25 pounds.
- Frequently bend body downward and forward by bending spine at the waist.
- Be able to stand and move about regularly.
