

Disclosure of Institutional (General Student Body) Graduation/Completion and Transfer-out Rates

Sterling College is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's graduation/completion rates. The information is provided in compliance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended. The rates reflect the graduation/completion status of students who enrolled during the 2005-2006 school year and for whom 150% of the normal time-to-completion has elapsed.

During the fall semester of 2015, 141 first-time, full-time, degree-seeking Undergraduate students entered Sterling College. This cohort has been adjusted to 140. After 6 years, as of August 31, 2021, 40% of these students had graduated from our institution or completed their programs.

- The graduation/completion rate is based on 6 years of attendance that equates to 150% of our longest programs.
- We have elected not to report our transfer-out rate because our college's mission does not include providing substantial preparation for students to enroll in other institutions.
- The graduation/completion rate does not include students who left the school to serve in the armed forces, on official church missions, or in the foreign service of the federal government. Students who died or were totally and permanently disabled are also excluded.
