



Disclosure of Sterling College Graduation/Completion Rates:

"Sterling College is pleased to provide the following information regarding our institution's graduation/completion rates. The information is provided in compliance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended. The rates reflect the graduation/completion status of students who enrolled during the 2013-2014 school year and for whom 150% of the normal time-to-completion has elapsed." During the fall semester of 2013 there were 169 first-time degree-seeking Undergraduate students that entered Sterling College. The cohort remains unadjusted at the time of evaluation. After six years, as of August 31, 2019, 53% of these students had graduated from our institution or completed their program. While reviewing this information, please bear in mind:

1. The graduation/completion rate is based on 6 years of attendance that equates to 150% of our longest program.
2. We have elected not to report our transfer-out rate because our college's mission does not include providing substantial preparation for students to enroll in other institutions
3. The graduation/completion rate does not include students who left the school to serve in the armed forces, on official church missions, or in the foreign service of the federal government.
