

## **Application to Live Off-Campus**

Sterling College is a residential campus. Through its liberal arts mission, Sterling College requires students to live in campus housing to experience campus life in its entirety. **Application is not a guarantee of off-campus status.** All full-time Sterling College students are required to live in campus housing unless they meet one of the following criteria. Returning students must renew their application yearly.

The completed application must be submitted to the Student Life Office for approval before a student confirms off-campus housing arrangements. Be reminded that it is the student's responsibility to make sure the application is approved before signing a lease, as a lease does not qualify as a special circumstance. Once you receive approval and confirm your living arrangements, please return to the Student Life Office to complete the Sterling College Off-campus Address section of this form. If you fail to complete this section of the form, your account will be placed on hold until we receive your offcampus address information. The student will be notified of a decision through email if all necessary information/documentation requested was provided. Incomplete information may result in delay of the application process. Applications that do not meet the deadline may be subject to an administrative fee of \$100.00. Please complete ALL of the following information. Students choosing to live off-campus will forfeit one third of their institutional financial aid. By signing below, I acknowledge that the above information is true and accurate. ## VERIFICATION FORM

For Students Requesting to live Off-Campus

To Parents & Legal Guardians:

The Sterling College Campus Housing Policy states that all full-time students who are unmarried, under 23 years of age, without dependent children, and not living with a parent or legal guardian must live in a campus residence hall and participate in the residential student meal plan.

Your son/daughter has requested permission to live off campus with you in your primary place of residence. "Living at home with a parent or legal guardian" assumes that the student is commuting daily to the campus from the parent's/guardian's home, eating most meals at the parent's/guardian's home, sleeping at the parent's/guardian's home (except on rare occasions), and is listed as a dependent.

Before students can receive final approval, we require the student and his/her parent/legal guardian to sign this verification form in the presence of a Notary Public to verify that the student will indeed be living at home with the parent/legal guardian in their primary place of residence or in the specified location on the front.

It is important that you and your son/daughter understand that should the College discover that your son/daughter is not living with you in your primary place of residence on a daily basis, your son/daughter will be held financially responsible for the minimum fees for room and board.

A representative from the Student Life Office may call to confirm this verification. Please provide a number where you can be reached.
