

Application to Live Off Campus

Sterling College is a residential campus. Through its liberal arts mission, Sterling College requires students to live in campus housing to experience campus life in its entirety and to encourage strong academic performance.

Completing an application to live off campus is not a guarantee of off campus status.

All full time Sterling College students are required to live in campus housing unless they meet one of the following criteria. Returning students must renew their application yearly.

Please check of the following that apply for the current academic year.

- A student who is or has previously been married (verification may be requested)
- A student with local dependents
- A fifth year student in good academic standing (at least 2.0 GPA)
- At least 21 years of age, earned 90 academic credits and be in good academic standing (at least 2.0 GPA)
- A student living with a parent or legal guardian. Verification form (back) must be completed.
- A part-time student
- A student with a medical circumstance. Must attached a detailed explanation and a physician's note indicating why student should be granted an exception to the Sterling College Housing Policy. Contact information for the physician should be included.

The completed application must be submitted to the Student Life Office for approval **before** a student confirms off campus housing arrange-

The student will be notified of a decision through email after all necessary information/documentation requested was provided. Incomplete information may result in delay of the application process.

- Applications for Off Campus Housing will be considered until the last day to Add/Drop each semester.
- Students who are found to have provided fraudulent or misleading information on their application will be charged for room and board for the semester in question.
- Students who have received permission to live off campus must inform the Student Life Office of any changes that would affect their eligibility to live off campus.
- Students choosing to live off campus will forfeit **one third** of their institutional financial aid.

I realize that providing misleading or fraudulent information may result in me being charged for room and board for the semester in question. I also understand that students who are granted permission to live off campus are responsible for knowing and abiding by all of the expectations of Sterling College students as outlined in the Sterling College Student Handbook. VERIFICATION FORM

For Students Requesting to live Off Campus

To Parents & Legal Guardians:

The Sterling College Campus Housing Policy states that all full-time students who are unmarried, under 21 years of age, without dependent children, and not living with a parent or legal guardian must live in a campus residence hall and participate in the residential student meal plan.

Your son/daughter has requested permission to live off campus with you in your primary place of residence. *"Living at home with a parent or legal guardian" assumes that the student is commuting daily to the campus from the parent's/guardian's home, eating most meals at the parent's/guardian's home, regularly sleeping at the parent's/guardian's home and is listed as a dependent.*

Before students can receive final approval, we require the student and his/her parent/legal guardian to sign this verification form in the presence of a Notary Public to verify that the student will indeed be living at home with the parent/legal guardian in their primary place of residence or in the specified location on the front.

It is important that you and your son/daughter understand that should the College discover that your son/daughter is not living with you in your primary place of residence on a daily basis, your son/daughter will be held financially responsible for the minimum fees for room and board.
