The Sterling College Campus Housing Policy states that all full-time students who are unmarried, under 21 years of age, without dependent children, and not living with a parent or legal guardian must live in a campus residence hall and participate in the residential student meal plan.

Your son/daughter has requested permission to live off campus with you in your primary place of residence. "Living at home with a parent or legal guardian" assumes that the student is commuting daily to the campus from the parent's/guardian's home, eating most meals at the parent's/guardian's home, regularly sleeping at the parent's/guardian's home and is listed as a dependent.

Before students can receive final approval, we require the student and his/her parent/legal guardian to sign this verification form in the presence of a Notary Public to verify that the student will indeed be living at home with the parent/legal guardian in their primary place of residence or in the specified location on the front.

It is important that you and your son/daughter understand that should the College discover that your son/daughter is not living with you in your primary place of residence on a daily basis, your son/daughter will be held financially responsible for the minimum fees for room and board.
