Strike System Contract

The terms of this contract are considered binding and absolute, and only changeable by a majority vote from SGA. It is vital to communicate with SGA about all related procedures.

Strikes will be given to a club, if:

- 1. The event that occurs was not approved by SGA
- 2. The Club President and additional member do not attend a GA Meeting without notifying the DCA
- 3. Posters are not submitted to the SGA Vice President and DCA according to the Publicity Guidelines
- 4. A major violation of the Budget Contract occurs, as deemed by the Executive Treasurer
- 5. A major violation of the Constitution or Bylaws occurs, as deemed by SGA
- 6. Two warnings have been issued against a club

Warnings will be given, if:

- 1. Event Evaluations are not turned in within seven days of an event
- 2. Posters are not put up at least one week before an event, according to the Publicity Guidelines
- 3. Posters are not removed within three days after an event, according to the Publicity Guidelines
- 4. Date/time of scheduled event is changed within one week of the previously approved date/time
- 5. The P-card is requested within three days of the approved event
- 6. Any email correspondence to the student body is not approved by the SGA Vice President or DCA
- 7. AV, marketing, or maintenance requests are submitted within two weeks of the approved event

After two strikes, a club will be put under evaluation and meet with SGA. The third and final strike will result in the suspension of said club for the remainder of the semester.

Furthermore, if a club does not put on two events in a semester (CAB must put on five events), said club will be put under evaluation.

Lastly, SGA reserves the right to disband a club in accordance with the Constitution and Bylaws.
