

WHAT TO BRING

A LIST OF SUGGESTED AND PROHIBITED ITEMS FOR YOUR STERLING COLLEGE EXPERIENCE

Sterling Dollar General stocks most items a student might need, including linens and personal toiletries. New students are encouraged to complete Personal Property Identification sheets at move-in which include model and identification numbers of electronics.



SUGGESTED ITEMS:

- **Small vacuum**
- **Carpet for certain dorms**
- **Few cleaning supplies** (especially for dishes you may bring)
- **Desk chair** (one can be provided if needed)
- **XL Twin bedding and mattress pad**
- **Towels, shower caddy, shower shoes, personal grooming items, and toiletries**
- **Hangers**
- **Over the counter and prescribed medications**
- **Small Appliances with auto on/off switch and no open coils** (fan, coffee maker, electric kettle, etc.)
- **Dishes for personal use in your room**
- **4.4 Cubic fridge** (must be plugged directly into the wall)
- **Laundry supplies** (pods or liquids for front loading machines)
- **Trashcan and trash bags**
- **Small couch, futon, or chair** **For room measurement go to: www.sterling.edu/student-life/housing*
- **2 Approved power strip/surge protectors** (must have light and plug directly into the wall)
- **Desk lamp** (non-halogen)
- **Electronics** (laptop, TV, and chargers)
- **School Supplies**
- **Important Documents** (Immunization record, insurance card, driver's license, social security card, etc.)
- **Winter wear**, blankets, and cold weather items
- ***some students may not be able to go home to gather these during the semester***
- **Personal recreation items** (pickle ball paddles, gaming systems, books, movies, etc.)
- **3M removable hanging strips, sticky tack, magnets, tacks, and hooks** (no tape, hot glue, screws, or nails may be used on the walls or furniture)

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

- **Weapons and firearms of any kind**
 - Weapons or ammunition of any kind cannot be stored in a student's room or vehicle while parked or driven on campus.
 - Fireworks, firearms, air-soft guns, blow darts, stun guns, other weapons, or any explosive device on campus is prohibited.
 - Bows and arrows, knives (other than pocketknife with a blade no longer than a driver's license), BB guns, paintball guns, and other items that can cause physical harm to others or damage to property.
- **Microwave, air fryer, space heater** and any appliances with an open heating element
- **Flushable wet wipes/dude wipes (they do not work with our sewer system)**
- **Indoor athletic equipment**

- **Extension cords or outlet expanders** (only approved power strip surge protectors are allowed, see picture CyberPower CSB6012 Essential Surge Protector, 1200J/125V, 6 outlets, 12ft power cord)
- **Wireless routers** (campus has accessible Wi-Fi)
- **Candles, incense, lighters**, or anything else with an open flame
- **Flammable materials**, such as gasoline, kerosene, and Coleman fuel products. Flammable décor, including live Christmas Trees.
- **Alcohol, tobacco products** (including smokeless tobacco or chew), **e-cigarettes/vape, and illegal substances.**
- **Pets** (only small fish allowed)
- **Large amounts of cash**
- **Irreplaceable valuables**
- **Drones or hover boards**
- **No tape, hot glue, screws, or nails** may be used on the walls or furniture.
