1. **POSITION:** Mound Ridge Camp and Retreat Center – Summer Adventure-Recreation Leadership
 - 1.1. **Purpose:** To serve as Adventure/ Recreation Leader and to work with the Program staff and Camp Director to provide a quality Christian Education experience for all campers and staff.
 - 1.2. **Accountability:** The Adventure/ Recreation Leader is accountable to the Director of Camp and Conference Ministries through the Camp and Conference Ministry Team of the Presbytery of Giddings-Lovejoy.
 - 1.3. **Relationships:** The Adventure/ Recreation leader serves with the Director, Manager and summer staff in leadership relationships characterized by communication, judgment, coaching, empowerment, vision, trust, learning, partnership and performance.
 - 1.4. **Terms:** The term of this position is for (9) nine weeks beginning the last week of May through August 1st (*may be modified depending on needs)
 - 1.5. **Conditions**
 - Must stay on camp premises throughout the summer program
 - Lodging, Meals, Adventures, and Accident insurance are provided
 - Criminal background check performed
 - May need to submit to alcohol/drug testing
 - Salary will be \$230 per week
 - This is a seasonal temporary position
 - 1.6. **Preferred Qualifications**
 - Must be at least 19 years of age, and one year out of high school.
 - Must have the ability to relate to others, particularly children and youth.
 - Must be an enthusiastic person who enjoys working out-of-door and with people.
 - Must be able to work in a cooperative manner with other staff people.
 - Must be a person who shows consideration for other people and sensitivity for the care of God's creation.
 - Should have background experience in facilitating ropes/challenge course, ground initiatives, and games.
 - Must be willing to learn and follow all safety guidelines providing a safe and fun experience to all.
 - Must be clear in explaining and consistent in enforcing challenge course rules.
 - Must have current First Aid, CPR, and Rescue Oxygen Certifications. This will be offered during orientation.
